It's 44-49297 and here is what I have on my database:

Type: B-24LSH (NITE). First trace on 6 Jan 45 inventory report. Was at 2 SAD, Abbots Ripton (Alconbury) on 6 Feb 45 for modification (it was the prototype B-24 for the AN/APS-13 tail warning project, which was unsuccessful for B-24s). Flew on 15/16 Mar 45 mission to Munster. Force or crash landed at Liège-Bierset (A-93) and was destroyed on 14/15 Apr 45 experimental and unsuccessful boming operation to Neuruppin airfield, on the Ruppiner See, about 40 miles north-west of Berlin. Salvaged on the Continent 19 Apr 45 by 5 SAD
