No MACR has been seen. The aircraft lost on 4 Jan 45 is listed as B-17 42-37530 in an appendix to Pat Carty's "Secret Squadrons of the Eighth". This is incorrect because B-17 42-37530 flew its last night leaflet operation on 9 Jul 44 before C/L on a cross-country flight.

44-10530 would have been painted gloss black and may have lost its name in the process.
